- 1. Senior Centers/Programs print out the following packet (3 pages total) for each senior that wants to participate. Print out in color so you can easily see who each letter goes to.
- 2. The packet has 3 letters noted at the top: 1) Mayor de Blasio 2) Speaker Mark-Viverito and 3) their Council Member. Each letter is translated in English, Spanish and Chinese. Letters are color coded with a different color banner at the top so you know who each letter is going to.
- 3. Seniors should sign the portion of each letter in the language they prefer and fill in the blanks with their info. Remember each senior should sign a total of 3 letters.
- 4. Collect the letters from all the seniors, organize into 3 piles (Mayor, Speaker and Council Member) and mail 3 bulk envelopes to:
